

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL  
MEETING OF THE VESTRY  
OF TRINITY CHURCH  
April 22, 2007**

The Vestry of Trinity Church met for the purpose of approving and planning the visit by the American Boychoir and Chorus Angelicus.

Present were: The Rev. Dr. Robert P. Clements, Alexis Dorf, Jim Conzo, Martha Baer, Mary Anne Carley, Roy Bickley, Cheryl Duntz, Linda Lloyd, Tom Schindler, and Geoff Brown.  
Absent was Martha Nesbitt

The meeting began with a general discussion of the concert of the American Boychoir and Chorus Angelicus on May 22 at 7 PM, along with details of the performance and related activities.

**Alexis moved, and Linda seconded a motion that we undertake the visit of the American Boychoir and Chorus Angelicus. The motion was approved unanimously.**

Geoff was assigned to advise the Diocese of the concert, and to include the concert on the Trinity Update and the website.

Tom will prepare press releases for the Lakeville Journal and the Litchfield County Times as well as any other newspapers that may be helpful in drawing an audience for the concert. Posters have been made available by American Boychoir, and these will need to be filled in with details and distributed both within our usual area and in the Torrington/Litchfield area, where Chorus Angelicus normally draws its audience, as well.

Trinity Torrington, the home parish of Chorus Angelicus, should also be specifically invited to the concert.

Fr. Clements will advise his colleagues in the Litchfield Deanery of the concert.

Trinity is responsible for housing the American Boychoir on Tuesday night. At this point, four additional homes are needed. Alexis noted that a schedule should be prepared for host families so they are aware of their responsibilities.

Trinity is also responsible for feeding the American Boychoir and Chorus Angelicus prior to the concert. The Vestry agreed to undertake feeding the performers as a potluck supper. Tom will determine food restrictions, if any, from his contact at the American Boychoir. The potluck will be for the performers, not for the parish in general.

As this represents a fund raising opportunity for Trinity, it was recommended that parishioners, particularly the Vestry, should underwrite the \$650 cost of the American Boychoir. Vestry members volunteered to contribute \$550 during the discussion. Checks should be made

payable to Trinity Church, with “Boychoir” in the memo line. Martha Nesbitt will be advised of this so she can properly account for the funds.

**Roy moved that adults be charged \$15 and students be charged \$8 for the concert. Martha Baer seconded. The motion passed.**

There being no further discussion, Alexis moved that the meeting be adjourned.
