- 1755 Christ Church, Sharon established
- 1775 American Revolution
- 1783 Samuel Seabury consecrated as Bishop
- 1812 War of 1812
- 1831 William H. Barnum born at Boston Corners, NY
- 1832 St. John's Church, Salisbury erected
- 1835 First blast furnace built in Lime Rock
- 1836 Barnum & Richardson acquire Lime Rock foundry
- 1840 William H. Barnum joins Barnum & Richardson
- 1842 Housatonic Railroad completed
- 1845 Furnace Village renamed Lakeville, CT
- 1848 Christ Church, Canaan separates from St. John's
- 1850 William H. Barnum elected to Connecticut legislature
- 1852 Barnum & Richardson acquire East Canaan furnaces
- 1861 Civil War
- 1862 William H. Barnum defeats P.T. Barnum for Congress
- 1864 William H. Barnum a delegate to Democratic Convention
- 1868 William H. Barnum becomes President of B&R
- 1870 Ames Iron Works closes
- 1872 Connecticut Western RR completed
- 1873 Trinity Church established
- 1875 W. H. Barnum elected Chair of Democratic National Committee
- 1878 B&R build wheel foundry in Chicago, IL
- 1880 Trinity corporation laid
